- 3. During the conversation Ms. Sullivan will ask questions about the agency's current electronic monitoring program, if one exists. She may also ask about existing policies and procedures. Ms. Sullivan will explain the importance of the EM program decision maker(s) to complete STOP's Program Management course, which is led either on a conference call or in person. Ms. Sullivan will coordinate with STOP's training department and the agency to schedule a time for the EM program decision maker(s) to participate in the Program Management course.

The Program Management course addresses a variety of issues any EM program encounters, such as grace periods and sanctions for various types of violations and procedures for supervising officers to follow when responding to violation notifications. This course is especially important if the agency is adding Global Positioning System (GPS) technology to its suite of supervision tools. GPS monitoring requires a different approach to violations than radio frequency (RF) monitoring and STOP wants to do everything possible for the agency to have policies and procedures in place prior to the start of the program.

Ms. Sullivan can also arrange for the agency to speak with other STOP customers who have a similar operating structure and program size. This discussion can help the agency learn from an existing customer about its EM program and its best practices, policies and procedures.

Ms. Sullivan will also coordinate all training needs between STOP's training department and the EM program decision maker(s). STOP provides training either on-site or online, whichever is best for the agency.
