## **Special Terms and Conditions:**

### **1. Definitions**

**DOAS-** Department of Administrative Services

**The State-** State of Georgia

**LP Gas-** Liquefied Petroleum Gas

**Issuing Officer-** Buyer's contracting personnel.

**Eligible User-** All governmental agencies that have a physical presence in the State of Georgia as well as any independent, not-profit college or university that is located in the State of Georgia.

**Dealer-** Any person who sells or offers to sell liquefied petroleum gas to an ultimate consumer for agricultural, industrial, commercial or domestic use.

**Dispensing Operation:** A dispensing facility or vehicle fuel dispenser as defined in NFPA 58 and used to dispense liquefied petroleum gas to the ultimate consumer.

**Installation:** The act of installing apparatus, piping, tubing, appliances, and equipment necessary for storing and converting liquefied petroleum gas into flame for light, heat, cooling or power for use by the ultimate consumer.

**“Bulk” delivery-** orders over 9,000 gallons

**“Retail” delivery-** orders up to 4,500 gallons

### **2. Period of Agreement**

The initial term of the statewide contract is for two (2) calendar years from the execution date of the contract. DOAS shall have four (4) one (1) year options to renew, which options shall be exercisable at the sole discretion of DOAS.

### **3. Multiple Awards**

Any contract award(s) resulting from the eRFQ will only be made to responsive and responsible Bidder(s) meeting all specifications and with whom DOAS has reached agreement on all contract terms and conditions. DOAS anticipates making contract award on a per county basis to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder per county; however, in the interests of coverage, DOAS reserves the right to select one or more Bidders for award and to award all items to one or more Bidders, individual line items to one or more Bidders, or counties/regions to one or more Bidders when to do so is in the best interests of the State of Georgia.

#### 4. Delivery terms

- a. The “retail” and “bulk” orders shall be delivered within 48 hours after receipt of Purchase Order Release. Failure to comply will result in cancellation of the contract. When ordered propane has not been delivered within the terms and time frames specified herein, substitute propane may be purchased from another supplier and the contractor will be responsible for paying any additional acquisition costs. Habitual late or otherwise non-complying deliveries shall be grounds for contract termination and recovery of damages.  
The Vendor will not be held responsible for failure to deliver y caused directly by fire, flood, strike, Acts of God, Act of the Government, or any other circumstance which in the Division’s opinion is beyond the control or fault of the Vendor.
- b. Pumping and metering (including metered delivery tickets) are required for all deliveries.
- c. Prospective bidders are expected to visit the various sites to determine if any special equipment or procedure will be required to properly service the account. The submission of a bid will be considered as conclusive evidence that the bidder has made such examination and/or is satisfied as to the conditions to be encountered in the performing of the work and fulfilling the requirements of the contract.
- d. The successful bidder(s) will be required to contact the Agency to determine the hours the Agency can accept deliveries.
- e. Minimum Order Requirements for “retail” deliveries: Minimum order quantity under this contract is 50 gallons for “retail” deliveries.

Minimum order quantity under this contract is 9,000 gallons for “bulk” deliveries.

“Retail” delivery- For orders less than 50 gallons, delivery charge of X dollars (Fixed surcharge is requested in the price sheet) will be added to the invoice as a separate item in addition to the amount of product delivered.

If the facility is on “keep full program” the requirement for fixed surcharge must be waived, customer is not responsible for any additional charges.

- f. Delivery Completion: delivery shall be considered completed only when propane has been shipped FOB Destination and placed into the purchaser’s propane tank(s).
- g. Routine Deliveries: for routine orders placed by the purchaser, the contractor shall schedule deliveries during normal working hours within a guaranteed maximum of three (3) calendar days after receipt of order. However, on a case-by-case basis for remote delivery locations, the purchaser and contractor may agree on a later delivery time.
- h. “Keep Full Program” Deliveries: purchasers may request to participate in the contractor’s “Keep Full Program” if the contractor has such a program for their other customers. Under this program, contractor shall schedule deliveries at its convenience as authorized by the purchaser. Further, contractor guarantees that “Keep Full Program” customers will not run out of propane. If they should run out, contractor agrees to make a delivery as quickly as

possible, but not later than twenty-four (24) hours. The bid margin will remain the same for this service.

- i. **Emergency Deliveries:** should an emergency situation arise, the contractor guarantees delivery within a maximum of twenty four ( 24) hours after notifications of need or as required by the purchaser in response to an emergency. The Contractor may charge a reasonable service charge for such deliveries in addition to normal product charges and bid margins, based on the nature of the emergency and the extent of additional costs incurred. The State reserves the right to approve additional charges before the order is processed. Supplier must get the approval of the State before delivering the order.

## **5. Tank installation and maintenance**

Bidder(s) are required to submit hourly labor rates for installation and maintenance as requested in the Price Sheet. Through this contract, purchaser may request that the contractor provide: delivery of propane storage tank(s), assistance with the installation of a purchaser owned tanks(s), tank installation and set-up, necessary permits or fees, parts, supplies and piping. For some new installations, contractors may also be asked to provide concrete base slabs on which to set propane storage tanks, concrete slab and storage tank delivery and set-up services, trenching services, pipe installation services, pressure regulators and concrete filled bollards. For evaluation purposes, bidders are required to submit hourly maintenance and installation rates only. Cost of additional supplies and parts will be reimbursed by customer upon inspection of invoices submitted by supplier. No administrative mark up on parts and supplies will be provided; bidders must factor administrative costs into submitted hourly rates. All supplied equipment and services must comply with established federal, state and local codes and regulations. A copy of the applicable equipment or the company's warranty shall also be furnished at the time services or equipment is provided.

## **6. Tank rental**

Contractors must have propane tanks available on a rental basis. Contractor's monthly rental rates are requested in the Price Sheet and will be fixed throughout the term of the contract, rental rates are subject to revision upon contractor's request at the time of contract renewal, the State reserves the right to evaluate and negotiate any rate increase requests. Contractor may ask purchaser to sign their standard rental agreement, provided the resultant agreement does not have any conflicts with the Georgia Statewide Contract.

Tank rental fees are requested in the Non-Core Price Sheet tab of the eRFQ Price Sheet worksheet. Quantity column represents the number of Vendor Owned tanks at various State locations. Quantities reflect the number of tanks that are expected to be rented by the State Agencies and are not guaranteed quantities. Quantities of tanks are based on the number of currently rented tanks.

**7. Tank removal**

The appropriate State Agency will coordinate the removal of Vendor Owned Tanks (VOT) as necessary. Vendor shall cooperate with the Agency in the removal of tank and shall require not more than 72 hours following notification for removal. In those instances when Vendor Owned Tanks must be removed due to contract awarded to another Vendor, the Agency may (at its discretion) continue to rent the tank at the rate provided by contract until the remaining fuel is used or elect to have the tank removed with the remaining Liquid Petroleum Gas. The new Vendor will be responsible for supplying another Vendor Owned Tanks at the quoted rental price. If the Vendor Owned Tanks are removed prior to using all the Liquid Petroleum Gas, the Vendor shall provide a credit based upon the last delivered price and the remaining Liquid Petroleum Gas in the tank. In either case, no rental charges will be paid beyond three (3) working days following notification to pick up.

Vendors shall comply with the Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration, Bureau of Motor Carrier Safety, Code of Federal Regulations Title 49, parts 100 through 199 and parts 390 through 397. Further, the Vendor shall ensure that any other applicable law, regulation, ordinance and the contract specifications are followed in the removal of Vendor Owned Tanks, delivery of Vendor Owned Tanks and delivery of Liquid Petroleum Gas.

**8. Commodity Pricing and Invoices**

- a. The contractor’s delivery receipt is to be signed by purchaser’s representative at time of delivery. In rare instances, when the delivery driver is unable to locate the purchaser’s representative, he/she may write “no one available to sign” on delivery receipt and sign it themselves.
- b. Pricing shall be established on the “**DAY OF DELIVERY**”. Fuel prices will be adjusted on a weekly basis with adjustments becoming effective at 12:01 A.M. each Monday. The price paid per gallon for Liquefied Petroleum Gas will increase or decrease on a weekly basis based on the previous week’s average price per gallon at the Milner, Georgia terminal as printed on the OPIS Reports. The price used will be based on Monday through Friday weekly average reading obtained on following Monday between hours of 8:00 A.M. and 12:00 PM. The weekly average price used for payment will be based on the date of delivery.
- c. The contractor shall prepare and submit an invoice to the purchaser for each delivery (or monthly if requested by purchaser).

## 9. Price Sheet and Awards:

Price sheet responses shall be submitted in the locations and formats provided in the Price Sheet in Section 5 of eRFQ document. Bidder must submit bids for a minimum number of three (3) counties within any region. The Firm Markup or Discount must include the vendor's profit, delivery costs, vendor surcharge fee, and any other costs the vendor wishes to include except to the extent the cost worksheet specifically requests that the cost be identified separately. "Retail" delivery mark up margin/Discount per gallon shall be submitted for each county, bidder(s) must submit both "retail" and "bulk" delivery mark up/discount bids for requested counties (Only select counties require "retail" and "bulk" delivery rates). Failure to provide "bulk" and "retail" delivery rates for select counties will result in disqualification of bidder for that county.

The State will use only Core Price Sheet to evaluate bids, Non Core price sheet will not be used in the evaluations. The State reserves the right not to award Non Core Price sheet components if they are found to be non-competitive or unreasonable.

Prices shall be per gallon for the Firm Markup or Discount to the Milner, GA terminal weekly average. The Firm Markup or Discount shall not change during the term of the contract. The average weekly price for Milner, GA shall be used as a basis for prices under this contract regardless of where the gas is purchased.

For the sole purpose of enabling the State to evaluate all bids consistently, the OPIS weekly average for **June 15, 2009** will be used to evaluate the total proposed prices per gallon, including the mark up margin/discounts.

## 10. Fuel Surcharge Usage.

Fuel surcharge will be effective if and when the price of diesel fuel exceeds \$3.50. Surcharge amount is calculated based on the number of stops per delivery. Surcharge amount per stop is \$2.00. Each customer will pay a surcharge for a stop at its location only. Number of stops and surcharge amount shall be indicated as a separate line on all invoices received by customers.

Diesel fuel price is OPIS weekly average price and posted by DOAS on weekly basis, supplier must use weekly average prices posted by DOAS in calculating surcharge fees.

## 11. Product specifications:

Propane shall meet the HD5-ASTM Specifications.

Propane HD 5 shall be a special propane for motor fuel and other uses requiring more restrictive specifications than Commercial Propane and shall conform to the following specifications:

**VAPOR PRESSURES-** The vapor pressure at 100°F as determined by NPGA LPG Vapor Pressure Test shall not be more than 200 pounds per square inch gage pressure.

**95% BOILING POINT** - The temperature at which 95% of volume of the product has evaporated shall be -37°F or lower when corrected to a barometric pressure of 760mm Hg., as determined by the NPGA Weathering Test for Liquefied Petroleum Gases.

**RESIDUE-** The product shall pass the non-volatile residue test and shall pass the oil ring test - each as determined by the NPGA Method for Determining Residues in Liquefied Petroleum Gases.

**VOLATILE SULFUR-** The unstenched product shall not contain volatile sulfur in excess of 10 grains per hundred cubic feet as determined by NPGA Volatile Sulfur Test.

**CORROSIVE COMPOUNDS-** The product shall cause no more discoloration to a polished copper test strip when such product is subjected to the NPGA LPG Corrosion Test than the discoloration of Standard copper strip Classification 1, as described in ASTM Method D 130-56, Table I, Copper Strip Corrosion by Petroleum Products.

**DRYNESS-**The product shall not contain free, entrained water.

**COMPOSITION-** The propylene content of the product shall not exceed 5 liquid volume percent and the product shall contain a minimum of 90 liquid percent of propane.

1. Renewal:
